


Tissue Paper Flowers

24 sheets of tissue make 48 small flowers using 4 (6" x 10") sheets or 32 flowers using 6 (6" x 10") sheets.


20" x 26" Tissue Paper Fold (13" Folded)

1. Use 2-3 sheets (folded) of tissue paper to make 4-6 sheet stacks.
2. Cut 1" off **folded** end (20" x 26" tissue) or 3" off (20" x 30" tissue).
3. Cut 12" length in half.
4. Cut 20" width in half.
5. You should have 4 stacks of 6" x 10" rectangles.
6. Fold each stack back and forth in 1" folds to make a fan.
7. Fold in half to find crease center.
8. Open fan and make 2 notches at the center leaving space between.
9. Wrap a twist tie or floral wire around notched center.
10. Cut rounded or pointed tips on each end.
11. Separate tissue papers on one side, then the other.
12. Fluff until beautiful!



20" x 30" Tissue Paper Fold (15" Folded)

Note: If your tissue is 20" x 30", you will cut off 3" off the folded side which can be cut in half lengthwise for 2 more flowers. For 15" x 20" flat packed tissue, stack 4-6 sheets and cut off 3 inches, then proceed with Step 3.



Mini Flowers: Cut 6" x 10" rectangles in half lengthwise to make them 5" x 6". Proceed with Step 6 making ½" folds for fan.

Medium Flowers: Use 3-4 sheets (folded) of tissue paper to make 6-8 sheet stacks. Skip Step #3 and only cut the 20" side in half to make a stack of 10" x 12" rectangles. Proceed with Step 6.
